

Coordinated Master's Program in Dietetics

Application Procedures

The Coordinated Master's Program in Dietetics is currently granted accreditation by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND) of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics, 120 S. Riverside Plaza, Suite 2190 Chicago, IL 60606 (312-899-5400). Further information is available at Eatrightpro.org/ACEND.

Students with a B.S. degree in nutrition, food science, or a basic science such as biology, chemistry, microbiology, or physiology often have an appropriate foundation for a graduate program in human nutrition. Students from the social sciences usually need to make up deficiencies in physiology, general chemistry, organic chemistry, biochemistry, and college algebra prior to admission.

Application deadline for the CMPD program is early December of each year.

ONLY CURRENT FSHN graduate students are eligible to apply to the CMPD. Exact dates will be announced to all FSHN graduate students by email each fall semester. The application will include a statement of professional goals and objectives, the completed Dietetic Internship Program Application (available from department), two letters of recommendation (one from a professor who is also the advisor and one from a work supervisor) and a plan for completion of all CMPD requirements. Notification of acceptance is made by late January with students beginning the CMPD in the following fall semester.
