

# Rapt Exchange

LOCATION: Seattle, WA

Located in the heart of Seattle, Washington, Rapt Exchange is a multi-use building created for a wide range of users, between 20-60 years old. Using "Opulent Exploration" as its main concept, Rapt Exchange develops a space where exploration is limitless but not limiting based off of age or level of technology usage. A major draw to this building is having a space that features diverse workshops, entertainment & hospitality. This creates infinite areas to explore, learn, and develop memories throughout the building. The overall building features a speakeasy bar with a mixology lab, workshop class spaces, a casual restaurant with a cooking class workspace, a boutique hotel, and a rooftop dessert bar & pool.

**Building Structural Expansion:**  
The building chosen for Rapt Exchange is an existing historical building in the heart of Seattle. The existing space consisted of 2 levels and a basement as a rough total of 15,000 square feet. To create more space to hold the different types of businesses within the building, the structure was expanded on a post and beam structure that was platformed over the existing building in order to follow historic building code compliance. This also included adding fire exit staircases around the building.




Level 1 Floor Plan





Level 2 Floor Plan




