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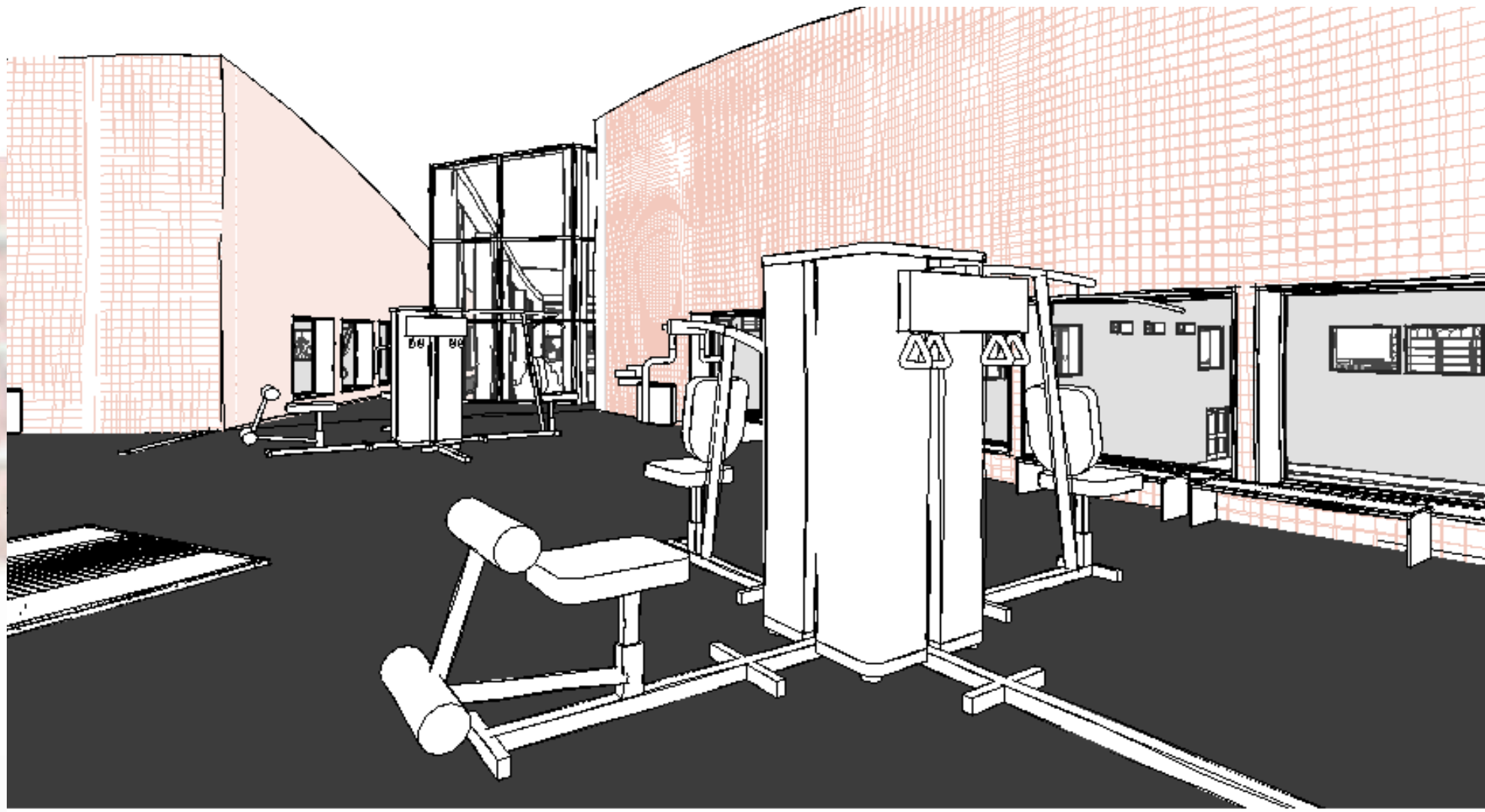
# The ReACT

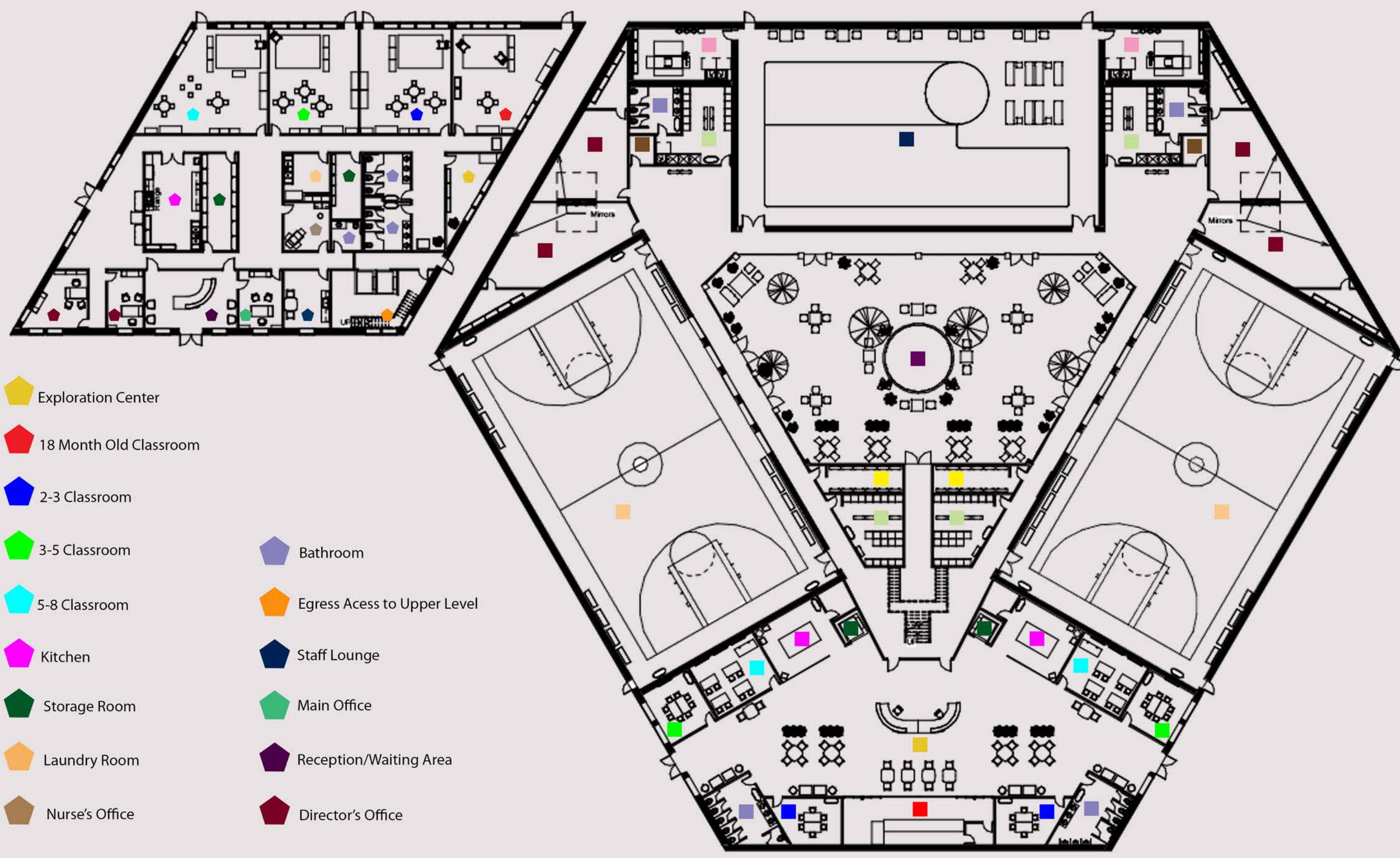

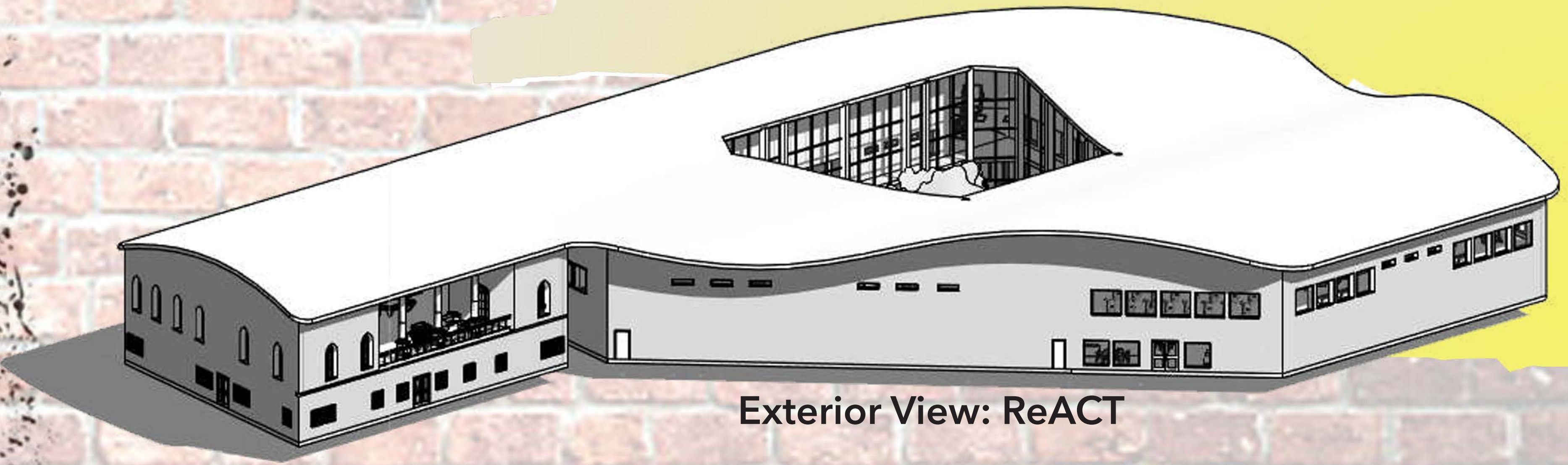


ReACT - Level 1

The ReACT has many amenities that At-Risk Youth and their families can utilize. There is a full-day low-income childcare center, Adult Professional and Personal Development courses are held here, there are spaces to reserve for studying, getting group projects done, or just hanging out with friends. The business model of the ReACT is built around the At-Risk Youth and Young Adults. They will work with one another and for one another, where as a team they are fully responsible for their locations. They will learn to work with each other and to depend on each other while learning real life skills within a low-risk business setting. Through both work and play they will be able to grow.
