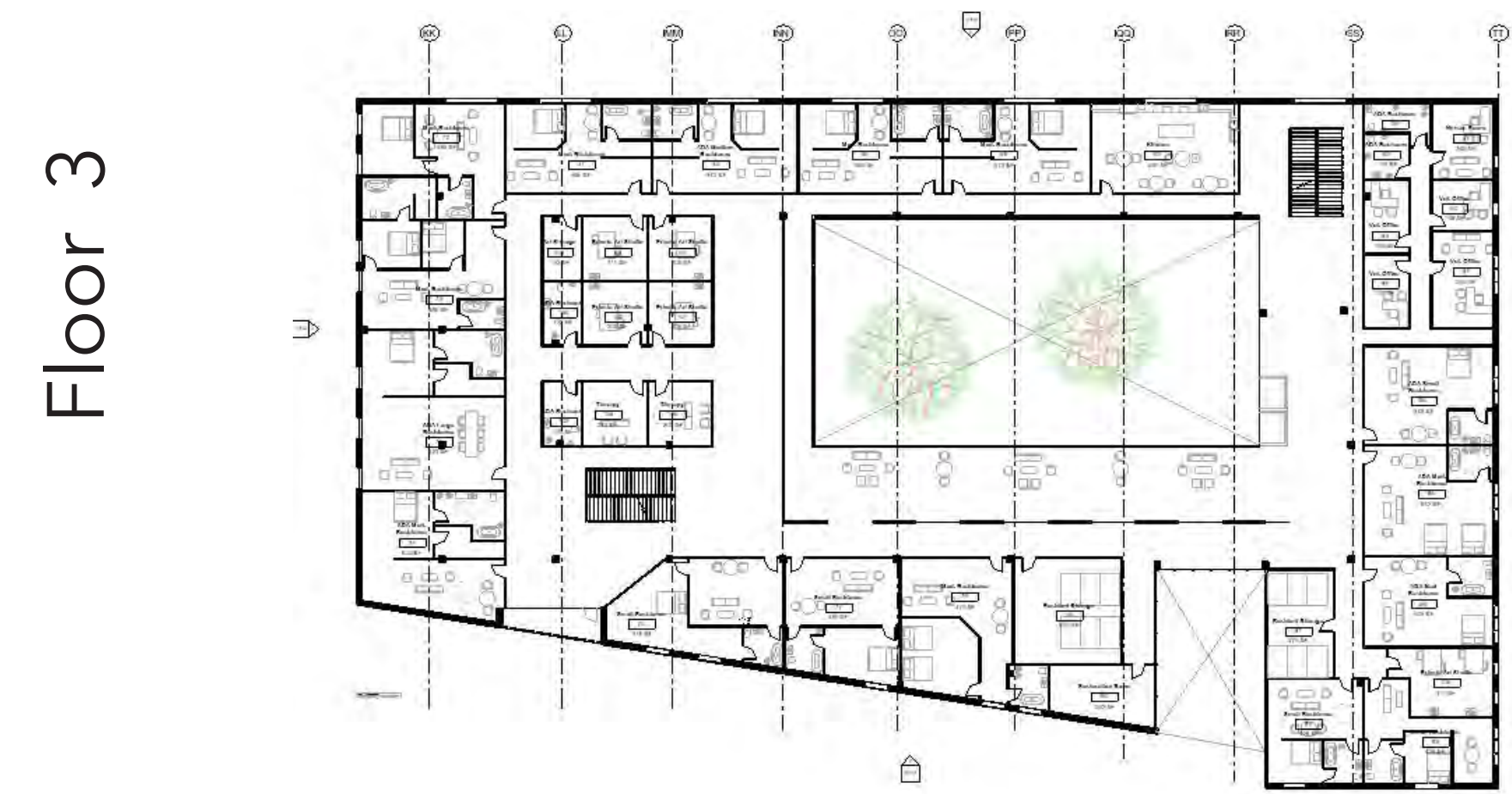
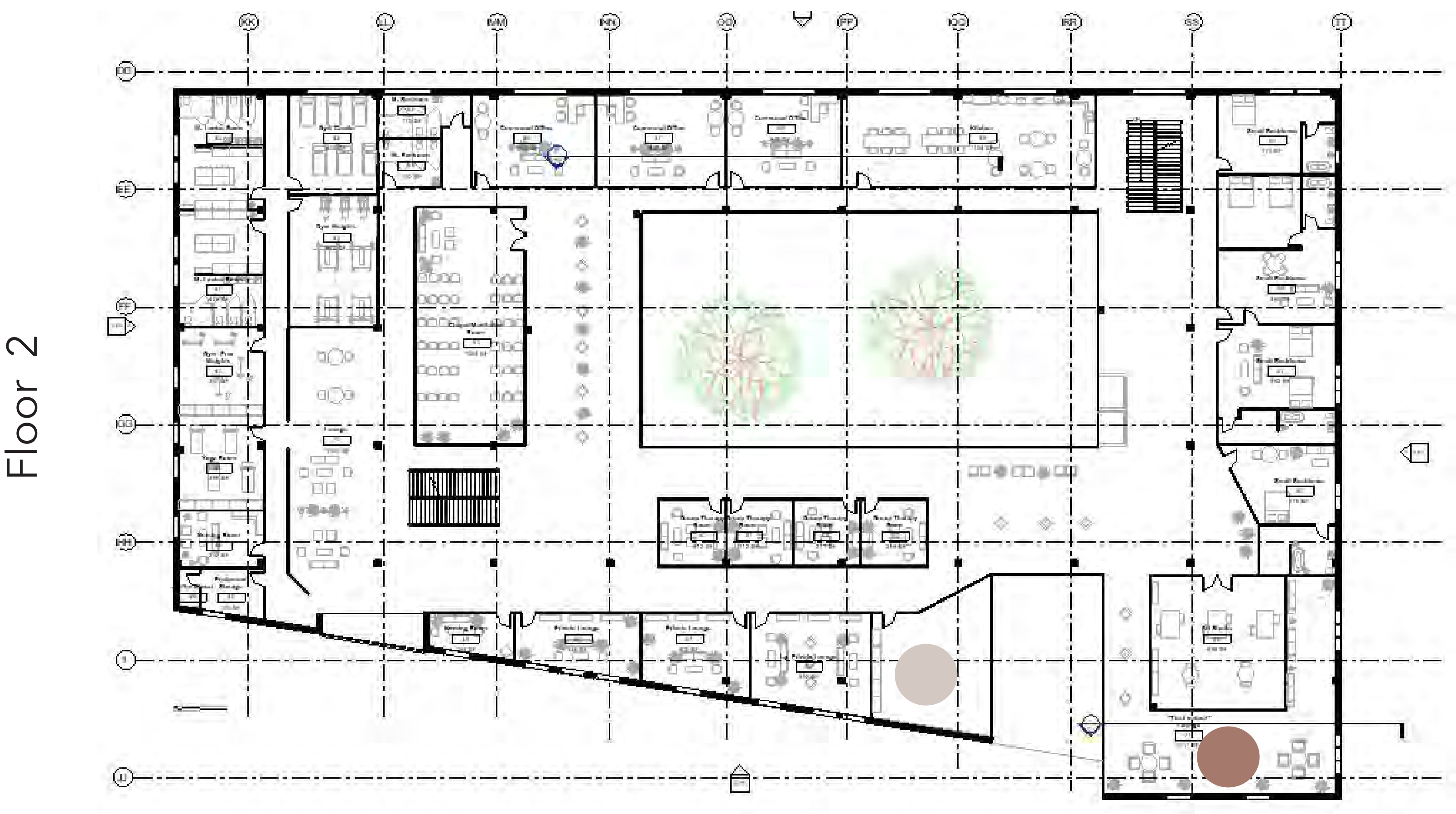
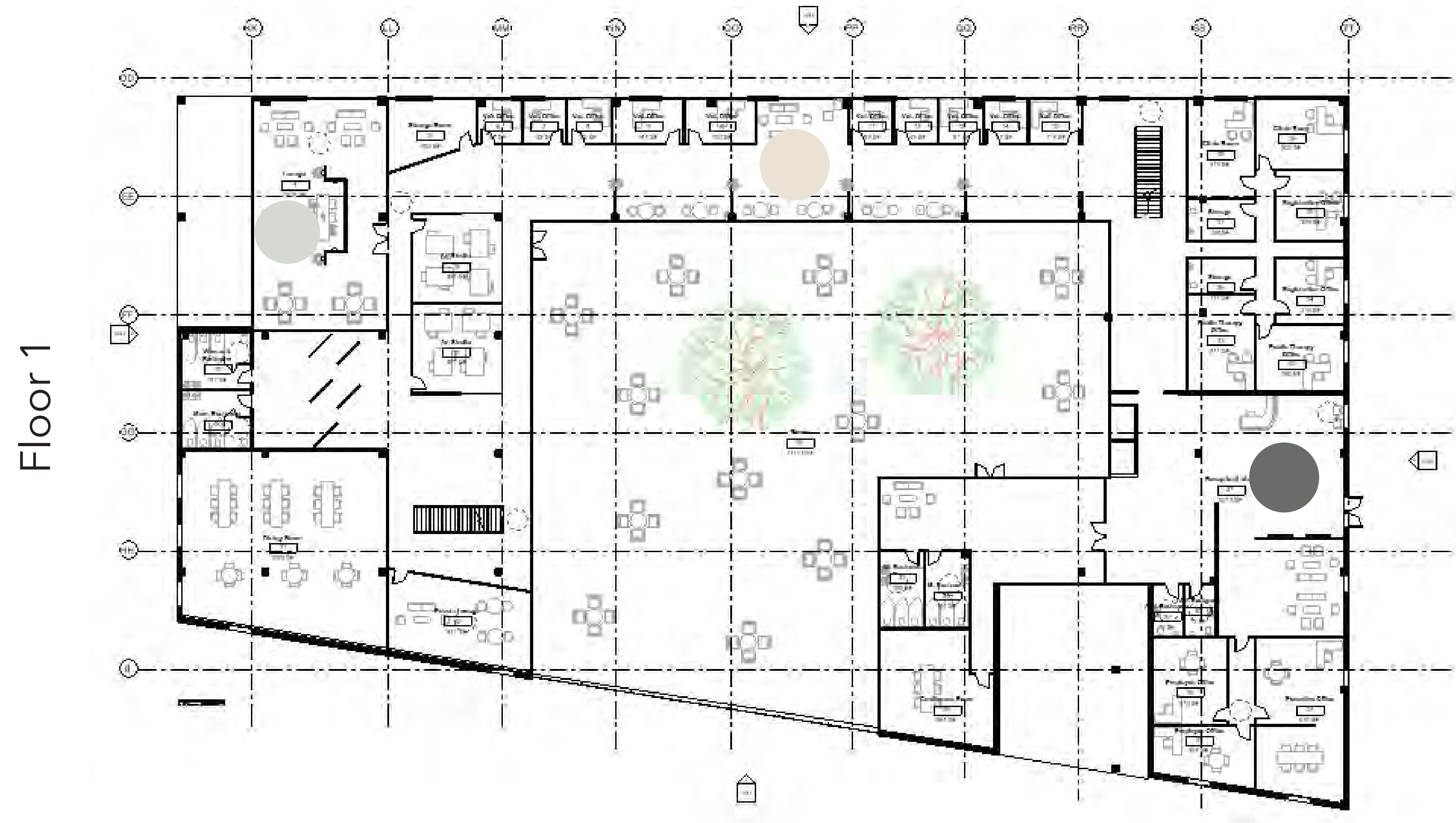

Les Cendres Safe-house

LOCATION: Fort Collins, Colorado

This safe-house is for women and children coming out of sex-slavery. In a city that has hidden brokenness in the sex-trafficking industry, this building is the first step to resoration for those who have been victims. The space will be surrounded by a security fence and is the perfect amount of privacy while still allowing the residents and their visitors to be outside, and feel safe. Les Cendres will be a place where their basic human needs are met before entering programs that will help their societal skills. Based off of Maslow's hierarchy of needs, this home was cultivated for women and children to heal, re-engage with themselves, with their trauma, and meet others who have experienced the same misfortune.



Spaces that are included vary. There are residential spaces that have a sleeping area, bath, closet, and living room for every resident. They will have community kitchen areas, lounges, and art studio's that can be reserved or be used as building community. Group therapy, solo-therapy, workout, and restoration rooms will also be included.
