Rockford, Illinois



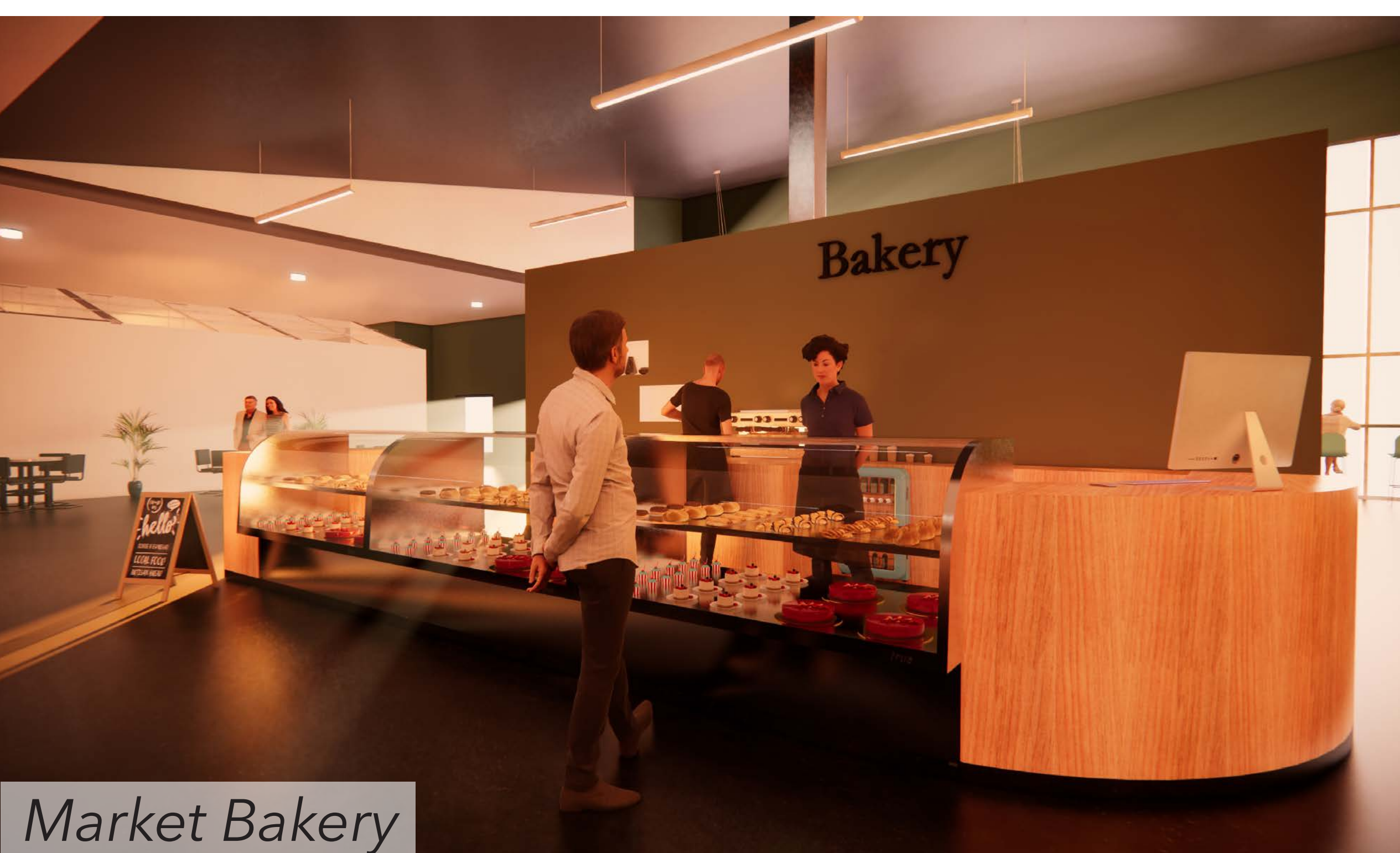

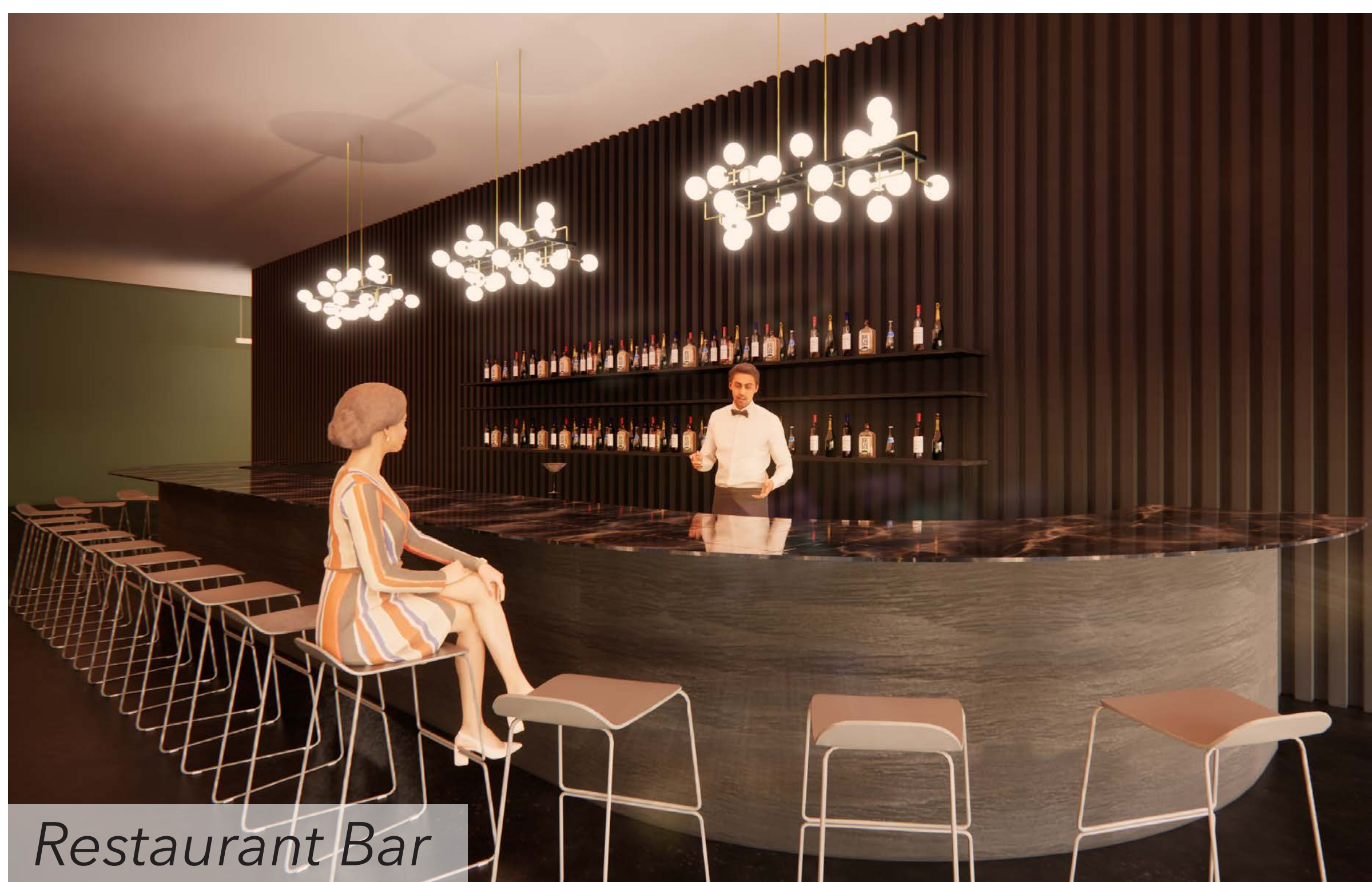

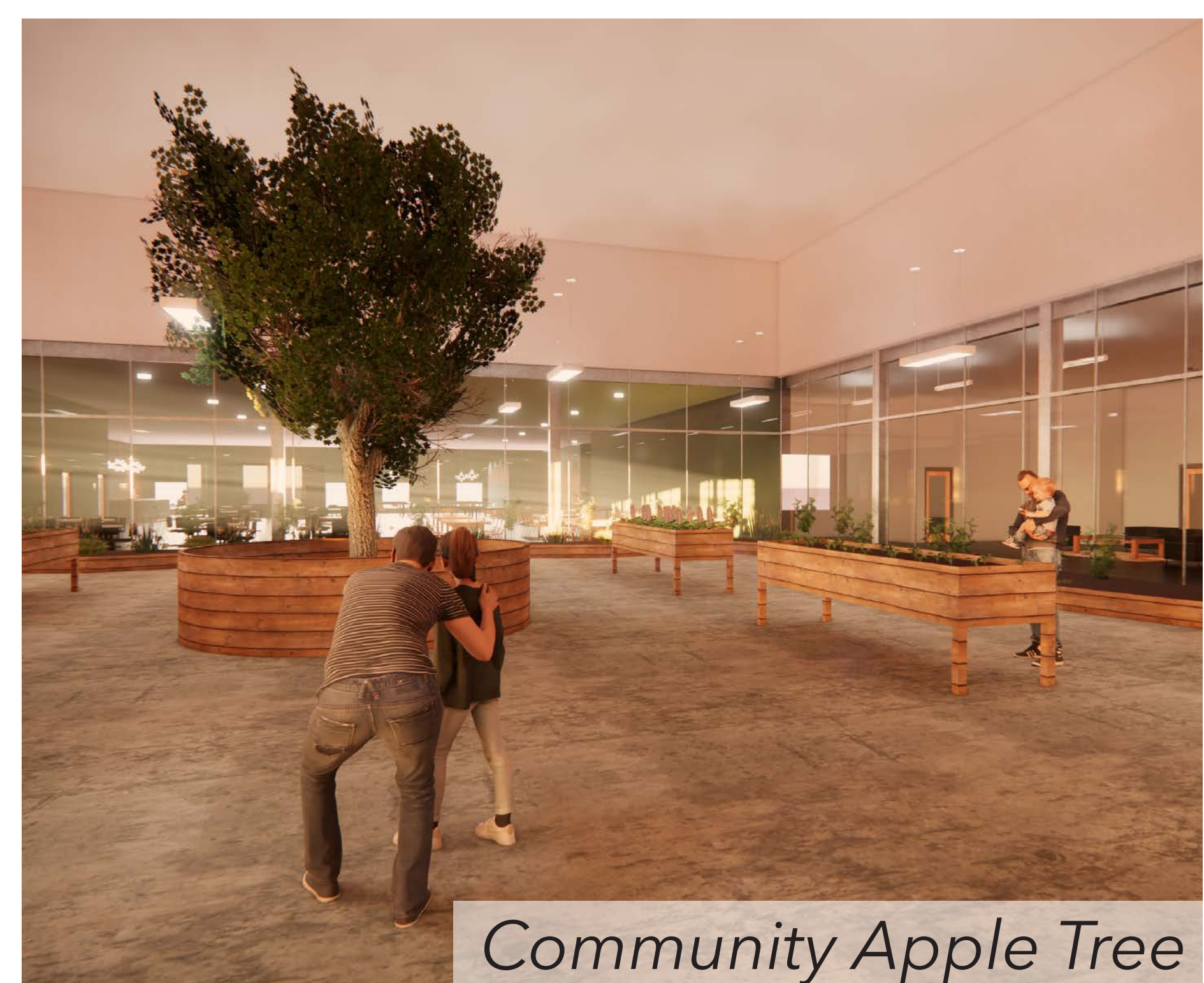
