WHAT IS PROSPER?

A system used by communities to help support behavioral health-focused prevention programs such as Strengthening Families 10-14 and Lifeskills Training.

WHY PROSPER?

- Involves proven skill-building family and youth programs that promote behavioral health.
- Provides **3 tiers of support** to ensure high quality program implementation and sustainability.

TIER 1: LOCAL TEAM

- Comprised of local Extension, behavioral health liaison, and school liaison
- Meet as a team to support program implementation and sustainability locally

TIER 2: TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDERS

- Work with local teams to provide resources and troubleshoot challenges
- Serve as a link between local teams and state team

TIER 3: STATE MANAGEMENT TEAM

- Convened by CSU's Prevention Research Center
- Develops the infrastructure to support community program implementation and sustainability
